## **E-LEARNING**

### **Cancellation Charges**

Individuals, who are unable to attend a course which has been confirmed, must cancel their booking via email ([erscb.training@eastriding.gov.uk](mailto:erscb.training@eastriding.gov.uk)) as soon as they become aware of this. A substitute may take their place, but this must be checked with the ERSCB training coordinator prior to attending the training session.

Cancellation charges **will** apply after a place has been confirmed if less than 5 working days' notice of cancellation is given prior to a course date. Cancellations will be accepted for those who are ill or have certain extenuating circumstances (*all telephone notifications **must** be followed up with an email to the above training inbox*).
